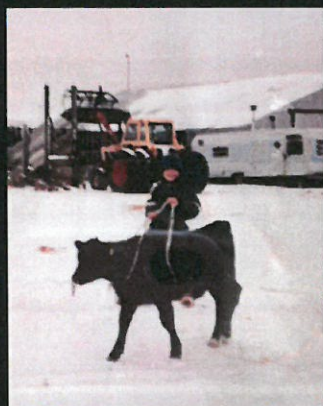

Jason was a hard worker and worked several jobs including being a ranch hand and park services in Medora. He loved working as a mechanic and loved carpentry work.

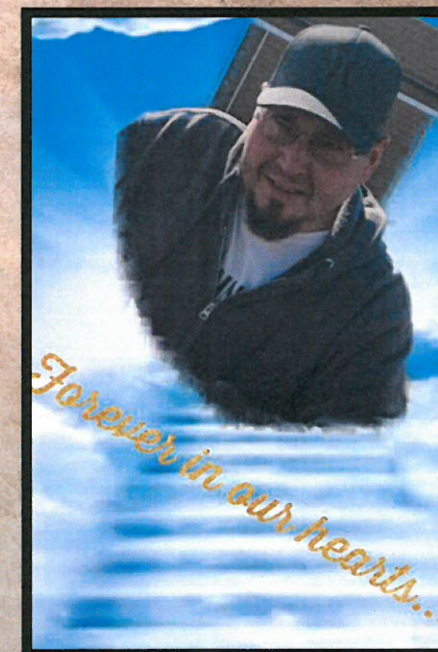
