

Ronald Dean Kerbaugh, 60, of Tioga, ND, passed away at the Tioga Medical Center in Tioga, ND on Sunday, October 3, 2021.

Ronald was born on July 11, 1961 in Williston, North Dakota to LaVerne and Ardella Kerbaugh. He attended school in Williston, ND through the 7th grade before his family moved to Tioga, ND.
