November 22, 2023

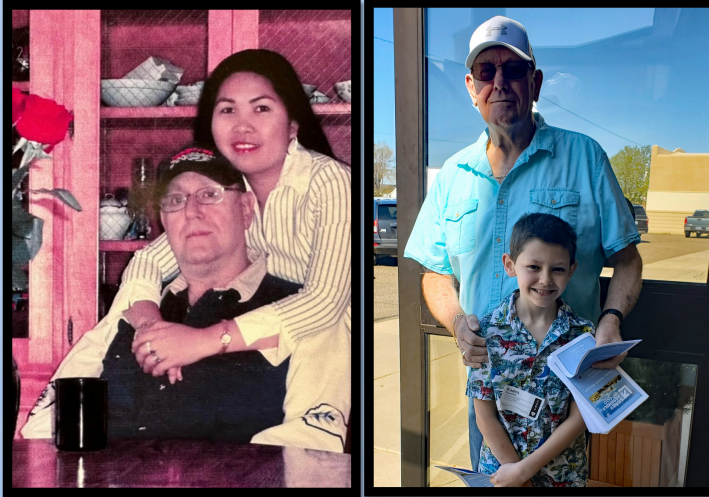




Dennis Lloyd Scheetz was born September 8, 1949, to Herman and Hilda (Odenbach) Scheetz in Sidney, Montana.
