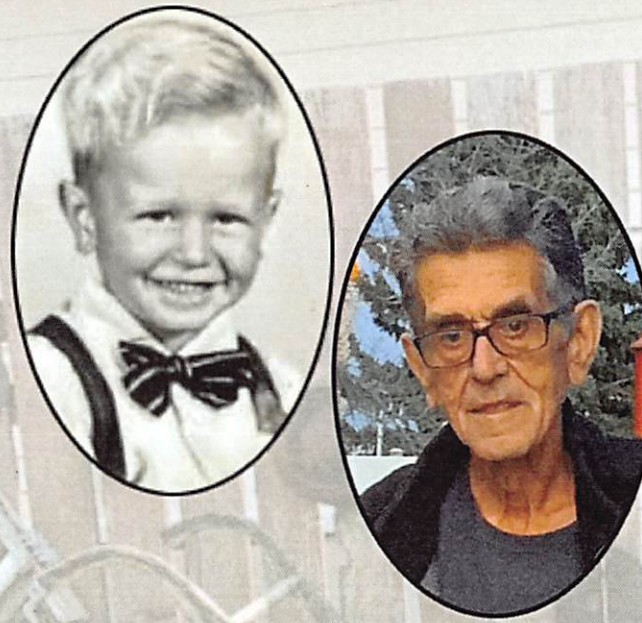

hard working hands at rest.

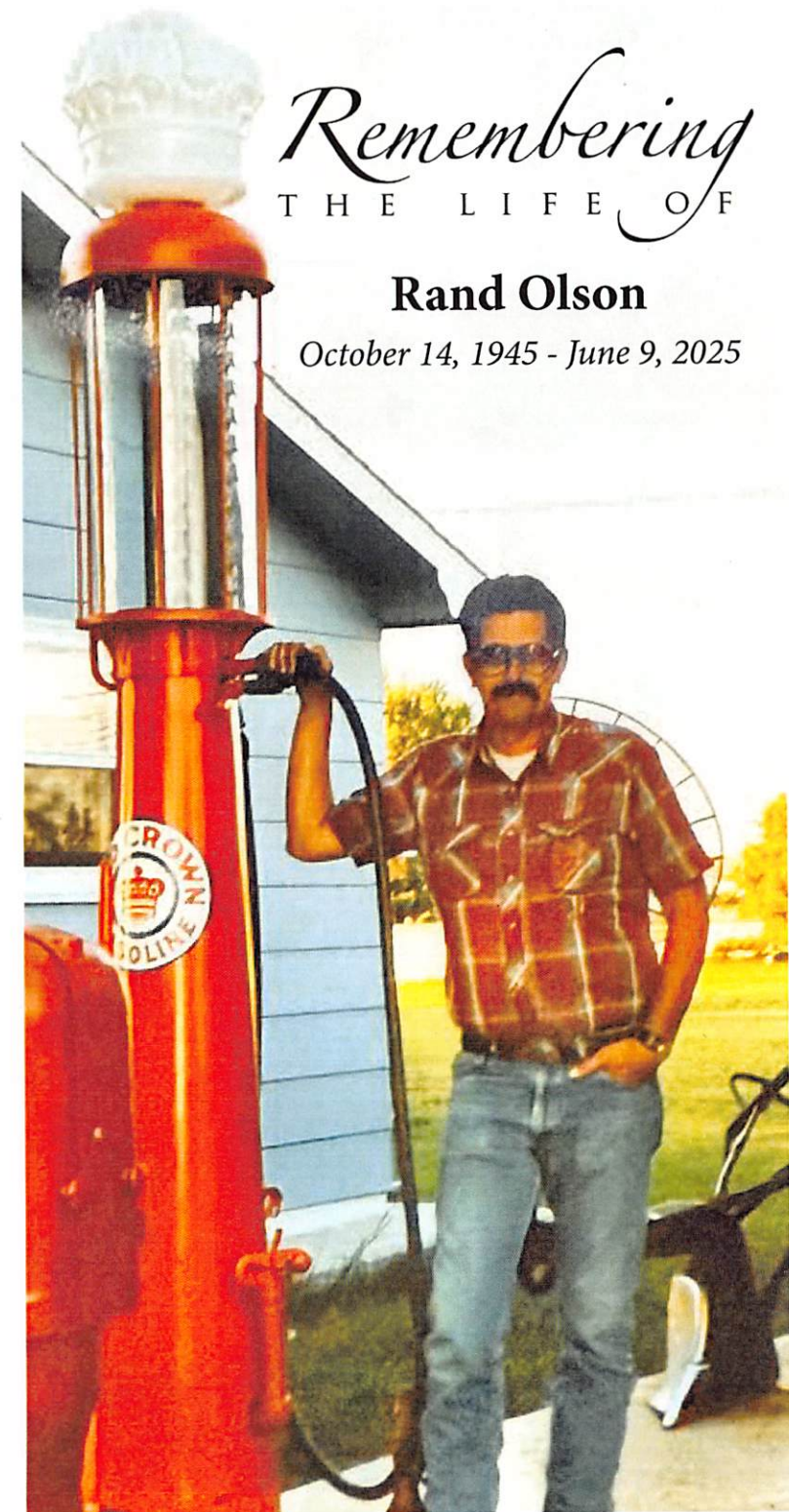

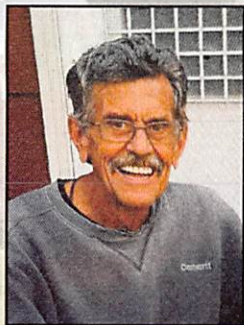
